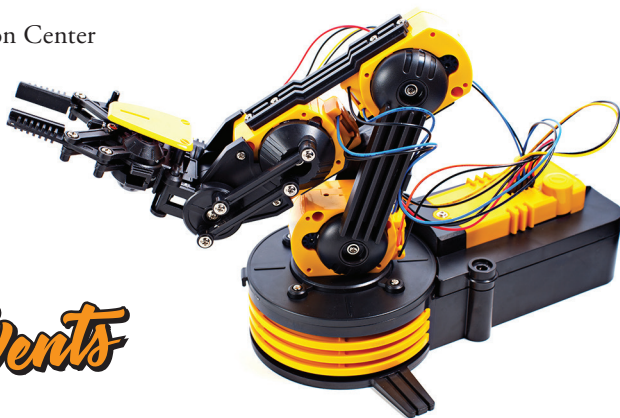

# Additional Services

## AMERICAN RED CROSS LIFEGUARD TRAINING

This course provides entry-level participants the knowledge and skills to prevent, recognize and respond to aquatic emergencies and to provide care for breathing and cardiac emergencies, injuries and sudden illnesses until EMS personnel take over. Students will receive a digital copy of the Lifeguard manual and a pocket mask. Check [www.NARiverRun.com](http://www.NARiverRun.com) for scheduled courses and to register.

**Dates & Location:** TBD

**Price:** \$160

**Minimum age:**

15 years (16 years old to work as a lifeguard)

**Prerequisites:**

Swim 300 yards continuously. Tread water for 2 minutes using only the legs. Complete a timed event within 1 minute,

40 seconds. Starting in the water, swim 20 yards. Surface dive to a depth of 7 - 10 feet to retrieve a 10-pound object. Return to the surface and swim 20 yards on the back to return to the starting point. Exit the water without using a ladder or steps.

**Note:** Students must actively participate and attend all course sessions to be eligible to take the written and skills assessments. Upon successful completion\* of the course, students will receive a Lifeguarding, CPR/AED & First Aid Certification valid for 2 years.

\*Those who successfully complete the course are encouraged to apply for employment at River Run Water Park. If hired, the full cost of the course will be reimbursed
