Progress for the Week:

- •MONDAY 11/9/20 Seven Seas did demo and prepped and poured driveway approaches at Harbrook. Seven Seas poured curb ramps at 7th St.
- •TUESDAY 11/10/20 Libs milled driveway approaches at Ellen Ct. Libs worked on replacement driveway section at Valley View. Seven Seas did demo of existing drives and poured back new driveway approaches at Harbrook. Seven Seas poured curb ramps at 7th street.
- •WEDNESDAY 11/11/20 Seven Seas prepped and poured driveway approaches at Harbrook.
- •THURSDAY 11/12/20 Seven Seas poured driveway approaches at Harbrook. Seven Seas poured curb ramps at 7th St. Laid out the limits of Beharrell and Ellen Ct. for milling.
- •FRIDAY 11/13/20 McCrite milled Beharrell. Libs supported their sub with traffic control and clean up. Libs poured replacement and moonlight driveways at Valley View and Beharrell. Seven Seas did demo at Harbrook. Seven Seas did reclamation and switched sides at 7th St. and also Harbrook.

2. Parking on Beeler Street

Mr. Nash stated that Councilman McLaughlin brought up parking issues on Beeler Street last week and stated that the thought it was faculty from the school parking on the street rather than their parking lot, which was fairly empty throughout the day. He reported that this shouldn't be an issue for a while because school has gone back to e-learning but asked Chief Bailey to have his traffic officers look into this.

TABLED ITEMS:

COMMUNICATIONS – CITY OFFICIALS:

- 1. Mickey Thompson re: Outdoor display tables
- **Mr. Thompson** stated that he was contacted by Sweet Stuff Bakery to request permission to place tables next to the building on the front and 4th Street side. He explained that these tables are not for outdoor dining but to display items so that customers can browse them outdoors. He stated that these tables would not impede traffic.
- Mr. Nash asked if they would be out 24/7
- **Mr. Thomson** stated that is one of the questions he reached out about but hasn't received an response. He suggested taking the item under consideration until he can speak with the owner again.
- 2. Micky Thompson re: No Parking on Ekin Avenue.
- Mr. Thompson stated that the contractors for the town homes project at Vincennes and Ekin are requesting a 40 foot section of Ekin to be marked "no parking". He explained that they were originally using the transmission shop on the opposite side of the alley for deliveries but that it is creating an issue for the owner of the transmission shop. He added that this coincides with a driveway that is going to go in at that location so they will have access to an area where they will be building a drive.

Board of Works November 17, 2020 **Mr.** Nash stated that if they approve this, he doesn't want to see any more issues with them blocking the sidewalk.

Mr. Thomson stated that this won't affect any residents or business in the area.

Mr. Thompson moved to approve, Mrs. Cotner-Bailey second, motion carries.



Progress for the Week:

- MONDAY 11/16/20 McCrite milled Ellen Ct. down to the gutter. Libs supported them with clean-up and traffic control. We proof rolled and laid out all of the partial and full depth HMA patching. Seven Seas poured curb ramps at 7th/Ohio St. Seven Seas prepped Market/1st St. curb ramp at S/E. Seven Seas poured two driveway approaches at Harbrook. Ct. and formed driveway approaches at Harbrook Dr. Seven Seas did demo. at Harbrook Dr. Received the ok to replace storm structure at 7th St./Market St.
- TUESDAY 11/17/20 McCrite milled all partial depth HMA at Ellen Ct., outside loop. Libs laid HMA Base, 25.0mm for patching where milled at Ellen Ct. Ellen Ct. began to fall apart where full depth patch needed. Then McCrite and Libs mobd over to Beharrell to mill out all of the HMA partial depth patching. Libs laid the HMA base back in the patches at Beharrell. Seven Seas poured curb ramp at 1st/Market St. then prepped curb ramp at 7th St. Seven Seas poured driveway approaches at Harbrook Dr. Seven Seas did demo at Harbrook Dr. All hands at Ellen Ct. to discuss full depth patching at the lead in road.
- WEDNESDAY 11/18/20 McCrite milled HMA partial depth patching at Ellen Ct. inside loop. Libs laid
 the HMA Base, 25.0mm for patching at Ellen Ct. Ellen Ct. continued to grow the pumping areas at the
 lead in road. Seven Seas did demo and prepped curb ramp at Market/1st N/E. Seven Seas poured curb
 ramp at 7th St. Seven Seas installed the new storm structure at Market/7th St.
- THURSDAY 11/19/20 Libs began to do full depth change order HMA patching at Ellen Ct. at lead in road where pumping. This consists of excavating 18 inches, install geotextile, 6 inches #2 stone, install geogrid, 6 inches of compacted aggregate, then lay 6 inches of HMA Base, 25.0mm. Libs laid all of the HMA for surface, 9.5mm at Beharrell. Seven Seas poured curb ramp at 7th St. Seven Seas poured driveway approaches at Harbrook Dr.
- FRIDAY 11/20/20 Libs worked on the full depth HMA change order patch at Ellen Ct. Libs hit water service at Ellen Ct. while doing the full depth patch, Libs shifted the focus to making the water line repair and getting the water off of the subgrade. Seven Seas finished pouring concrete at Harbrook. Seven Seas poured curb ramp at 7th St.

Upcoming Activities:

• Finish pouring curb ramps at East side of 7th St. Finish pouring curb ramps at Market St. Finish the full depth patching and get Ellen Ct. buttoned back up.

Construction Issues:

Finish the full depth HMA patching at Ellen Ct.
